Ms Cindy Koh is the Executive Vice President of the Singapore Economic Development Board (EDB) and a member of EDB's Executive Committee. The EDB is the lead government agency responsible for Singapore's manufacturing sector. Cindy oversees EDB's Advanced Manufacturing Group that works closely with international companies from diverse industries including Semiconductor, Healthcare, Mobility, Aerospace and Industrial Solutions, to facilitate their investments into Singapore, transform their operations here and help them succeed in Asia via Singapore.

Prior to her current appointment, she was the Executive Vice President responsible for EDB's International operations in 20 locations outside of Singapore from 2021-2023. Between 2018 and 2021, Cindy was Senior Vice President (Consumer) and held a concurrent appointment as Senior Vice President and the Head of Region for Americas, where she led EDB's operations in North and South America.

Cindy previously held positions as Director for Chemicals from 2015-2018 and Director, Resource Development Division (Planning & Policy) from 2013-2015. She was also the Centre Director of EDB's Washington DC Centre from 2005 to 2009. She joined EDB in 2002.
