Mr Yeoh Keat Chuan was appointed Assistant Managing Director of the Singapore Economic Development Board (EDB) on 1 January 2010 to oversee the government agency's investment promotion efforts in clean technology, electronics, infocomms and media, precision engineering and transport engineering sectors. He will hold this position concurrent with his role as International Director, Americas.

Keat Chuan has held several Director-level positions in the EDB since 1997, overseeing initiatives in divisions including the Americas and Biomedical Sciences Cluster.

As the International Director of the EDB's Americas Operations, he is responsible for investment promotion efforts carried out by the seven EDB offices located in North America. He joined the EDB as a Senior Officer in the Industry Development Division (Chemicals) in 1994.

Keat Chuan is a Glaxo-EDB scholar who graduated with a Masters of Engineering (Chemical Engineering), from Imperial College of Science, Technology & Medicine, University of London.
